FOOD FOR FAMILIES REPORT FORM SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION

St. Thomas More Council 7121 runs a Food Drive program every two months at St. Anastasia Catholic Church in Saint Augustine Beach, Florida, from September through May. Large 1/6 bbl kraft paper grocery bags are handed out by Brother Knights to people leaving Mass on the weekend before the Food Drive. The filled bags are collected the following weekend before each Mass, loaded into trucks, vans, and trailers for delivery to food banks. Monetary donations and gift cards are also solicited only as direct donations to the food banks, not to the Knights of Columbus nor the parish.

For fraternal year 2018-2019, the five Council 7121 food drives collected 9145 lb of food, with cash and gift card donations totaling \$6632. Food drive funds are kept exclusive of council accounts, with 100% of all donations received going directly and immediately to the food banks.

Each of the five Knights of Columbus Food Drives this year generated over 1000 lb of food donations, averaging slightly over 1800 lb. Monetary and gift card donations ranged from \$1085 to \$1522, with an average of \$1326 going directly to the food banks/shelter ministries every other month.




